INTRODUCTION TO THE LECTIONARY

Some of the traditions united in the Church of North Indian cherish the right of a Minister to choose the Scripture readings at Public Worship to fit in with the subject of the sermon, seen as a prophetic proclamation of the Word of God. But the choice of Scripture readings should never be done hurriedly or on the mere whim of the moment; and the value of the Lectionary suggested in the Almanac is that it ensures a balanced covering of the great Scriptural truths in the course of the year. Regular worshipers are thus taken through the whole Redemptive History.

In the Lectionary, the Sundays are numbered from the three great Christian festivals of Christmas, Easter and Pentecost. This is in order to bring out the great truth that our Christian hope rests on no doctrine, however true, nor on rules, however perfect, but certain events that have happened once for all, and principally on the three which together who the meaning of all the rest – the Birth of Jesus, his “Going to the Father” (his Crucifixion, Resurrection and Ascension) and his gift of the Holy Spirit to the Church.

**PLEASE READ THIS
TO UNDERSTAND THE ARRANGEMENT**

In this scheme three courses of Readings or sections are combined as follows:

READINGS FOR MAIN SERVICES ON SUNDAYS

Readings for main Sunday Services are printed in bold type in two columns in this lectionary, those for Morning or Evening Services (M/ES) on the left, and those for the Lord's Super (L.S)

READINGS FOR ADDITIONAL SERVICES ON SUNDAYS

Extra Readings for additional services in the morning or evening are printed in the appendix of this lectionary.

READINGS FOR WEEK DAY PRAYERS

Readings for Morning Worship (MW) and Evening Worship (EW) on remaining weekdays throughout the year cover the whole of the New Testament each year and as much as possible of the Old Testament in two years.

READINGS FOR FESTIVAL SERVICES

Readings for festivals are in the bold type. However, if a festival (eg., Epiphany) falls during the week day, it can be celebrated on the Sunday that falls after that festival day.

Appendix - III

Collects for the Year 2026

A Collect is a form of prayer that has been used in Christian worship for many centuries. Many Collects contain a profound Gospel meaning in a simple form which can enrich both private devotion and public prayer.

- a. In almost every Collect there are four parts:
- b. the address to God the Father;
- c. a reference to some aspect of God's nature or work in creation or redemption, to which we appeal;
- d. a short, simple and definite prayer, which follows from this;
- e. the offering of the prayer to the Father through his Son and in the Holy Spirit, which is also an act of praise to the Holy Trinity.

Collects are prayers that express, in simple and meaningful language, insights drawn from the Christian faith, from which prayer flows naturally. They serve as helpful models for both public worship and private devotion. One possible meaning of the word Collect is that it "gathers" the prayers of the people into a concise petition that all can affirm together. Historically, a Collect was used to summarize a series of petitions in a litany, and it may still serve this function today - concluding a time of free prayer or drawing together the themes of a larger prayer section.

The Collects for worship have already been published in the Book of Worship of the Church of North India by ISPCK. However, the Collects provided here have been newly composed in accordance with the revised lectionary for the year 2026. Churches have the freedom to use these Collects or any others as may best suit their context and worship setting.

January 1 – Naming of Jesus

Theme: *The Renewal of the Covenant*

Collect:

Almighty and Everlasting God, who in the fullness of time sent Your Son to be born of a woman and named Him Jesus, the name that is above every name, renew within us the covenant of grace sealed by His holy name. Grant that we who bear the mark of Christ may live as faithful covenant people, walking in obedience, love, and newness of life; through the same Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. **Amen.**

January 4 – 2nd Sunday after Christmas

Theme: *The Word Made Flesh:
God's Eternal Wisdom and Compassion*

Collect:

Eternal God, whose Word became flesh and dwelt among us, full of grace and truth, open our hearts to the light of Your eternal wisdom and fill us with Your compassion, that we may reflect the glory of Christ in our lives and share the hope of His incarnation with the world; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever. Amen.

January 11 – 3rd Sunday after Christmas / Baptism of Jesus

Theme: *The Servant King: Baptized to Fulfil All Righteousness*

Collect:

Gracious Father, whose beloved Son was baptized in the Jordan and anointed with the Holy Spirit to reveal Your righteousness, help us who are baptized into His name to live as humble servants of Your Kingdom. Strengthen us to walk in His way of obedience and self-giving love, that we may fulfil Your will in our daily lives; through the

same Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

**January 18 – 4th Sunday after Christmas /
Ecumenical Sunday**

Theme: *Called to One Hope:
A People Set Apart for Unity and Witness*

Collect:

God of peace and unity, who has called us into one body through the hope of our calling, grant that Your Church may be one in faith, hope, and love. Make us instruments of reconciliation and faithful witnesses to the truth of the Gospel, that the world may believe and all may be drawn into the fellowship of Your Son; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, forevermore. Amen.

**January 25 – 5th Sunday after Christmas /
Conversion of St. Paul**

Theme: *Transformed by Grace: From Persecutor to Proclaimer*

Collect:

God of grace and mercy, who turned the heart of Saul the persecutor into Paul the Apostle and proclaimer of the Gospel, transform our lives by Your redeeming love. Grant us courage to turn from our own ways and to follow Christ in faith and obedience, that, like Paul, we may bear bold witness to the saving power of Your grace; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, world without end. Amen.

February 1 – 9th Sunday before Easter (Septuagesima)

Theme: God the Creator and Sustainer of All Life

Collect:

Almighty God, you are the Creator of the heavens and the earth, the giver and sustainer of all life. Open our eyes to the wonder of Your handiwork, and teach us to steward Your creation with wisdom, humility, and care. May we honor You in all we do, trusting in Your providence and praising You for the gift of life; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

**February 8 – 8th Sunday before Easter (Sexagesima) –
Leprosy Sunday / Healing Sunday**

Theme: God's Healing Grace for a Broken World

Collect:

God of compassion and mercy, whose Son reached out to heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, and restore the broken, pour out Your healing grace upon our wounded world. Make us agents of Your love, bearers of hope, and instruments of Your healing in places of pain and despair. Renew our faith in Your power to restore all things; through Jesus Christ, the Great Physician, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

**February 15 – 7th Sunday before Easter (Quinquagesima) –
St. Stephen, First Martyr**

Theme: Faithful Witness: Boldness in Faith and Service

Collect:

Eternal God, who strengthened Your servant Stephen to proclaim Your truth and suffer for Your name, grant us such boldness in faith and love, that we, too, may bear witness to Christ with courage and grace, forgiving even as we are wronged, and serving even when it

costs. Empower us by Your Spirit to stand firm in the face of trials, through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever. Amen.

February 22 – 6th Sunday before Easter (Lent 1)

Theme: Tested but Faithful: Obedience in the Wilderness Journey

Collect:

Lord God, who led Your Son Jesus Christ into the wilderness and sustained Him in His testing, help us to walk in obedience through the trials of life, trusting in Your Word and depending on Your Spirit. Teach us to resist temptation and to remain faithful to You, that our lives may be shaped by the cross and made new by Your grace; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

March 1 – 5th Sunday before Easter (World Day of Prayer)

Theme: Christ Gives the Living Water of the Spirit

Collect:

Gracious God, who in Your Son Jesus Christ offers the living water that quenches every thirst, pour out Your Holy Spirit upon all who seek You today. May the streams of Your grace flow through us into a thirsty world, bringing healing, refreshment, and new life. Unite us in prayer and action, that we may be bearers of Your love to all peoples; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

March 8 – 4th Sunday before Easter (Lent 3)

Theme: Christ is the Light of the World

Collect:

Eternal Light, who sent Your Son Jesus Christ to shine in the darkness, illumine our hearts by Your truth and scatter every shadow

Empower us to proclaim the Gospel with boldness, and to serve with compassion in the name of Christ, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and always. Amen.

May 31 – 1st Sunday after Pentecost (Trinity Sunday)

Theme: God in Trinity: Holy, Sovereign, and Saving

Collect:

Holy and Triune God, you are beyond all we can know, yet ever close to those who seek You. In Your eternal mystery, you are Father, Son, and Holy Spirit-one God in perfect unity and love. Grant us grace to worship You in awe and serve You in faith, that we may live in the

power of Your sovereign love and saving truth; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

June 7 – 2nd Sunday after Pentecost

Theme: True Religion: Listening, Obeying, and Living in Peace

Collect:

Gracious God, you speak truth to those who listen, guide those who obey, and grant peace to those who walk in Your ways. Teach us the wisdom of true religion—that hearing Your Word, we may obey Your will, and in doing so, live in the peace that only You can give; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

June 14 – 3rd Sunday after Pentecost

Theme: A Heart of Prayer and a Life of Forgiveness

Collect:

Merciful Lord, you know the secrets of every heart and call us into communion through prayer and grace. Create in us hearts that seek You in prayer and hands that extend Your forgiveness to others, that our lives may reflect the love of Christ; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, world without end. Amen.

June 21 – 4th Sunday after Pentecost

Theme: Discerning the Truth in a Confusing World

Collect:
